

NOVICE PAIRS CHAMPIONSHIP

This event is primarily intended for students taking bridge lessons, Bridge for All Students, and social players new to duplicate bridge.

The field will be divided into approximately three groups to take account of varying levels of ability - eg 1st and 2nd year, 3rd and 4th year, and social or rubber bridge players new to duplicate bridge.

The emphasis will be on friendly and enjoyable bridge. Entrants do not need to be members of the Suffolk Contract Bridge Association.

The groups will play between 10 and 18 hands before tea (less experienced groups will play fewer hands at a slower pace). The entry fee will include a full tea of sandwiches, scones with jam and cream, cakes, tea and coffee. After tea, there will be further hands played and the event will finish at around 6.30pm - with prize giving by 7pm.

The Novice Pairs cup will be awarded to the leading pair at the end of the event which will be scored by computer over the entire field. Last year the event was won by Jilly Horrex and Fi Burrell - just 17 months after they first started learning the game!

The *Wivenhoe Salver* will be awarded to the leading pair in the 1st and 2nd year group.

There will be lots of prizes and certificates awarded at the final prize giving.
